The protection of your personal data is very important to us. We would like to explain to you below which data we process when and for what purpose.

Responsibility

Cookies

We use cookies on our websites. Cookies are small text files that can be stored and read on your end device. A distinction is made between session cookies, which are deleted as soon as you close your browser, and permanent cookies, which are stored beyond the individual session. Cookies can contain data that makes it possible to recognize the device used. In some cases, however, cookies only contain information on certain settings that cannot be related to a specific person.


We use session cookies on our websites. The processing is based on Article 6 paragraph 1 letter f GDPR and in the interest of optimizing user guidance.

You can set your browser so that it informs you about the placement of cookies. This makes the use of cookies transparent for you. You can also delete cookies at any time via the corresponding browser setting and prevent the setting of new cookies. Please note that our web pages may then not be optimally displayed and some functions may no longer be technically available.

Embedded content from other websites

Contributions on this website may contain embedded content (e.g. videos, images, contributions etc.). Embedded content from other websites behaves exactly as if the visitor had visited the other website.

These sites may collect information about you, use cookies, embed additional tracking services from third parties, and record your interaction with that embedded content, including your interaction with the embedded content if you have an account and are logged on to that site.



Application

You have the possibility to send us your application documents by e-mail. Your application documents will be accepted by the human resources department and will only be forwarded to the department responsible for the respective position or to the persons responsible for processing such applications. We use your application data to carry out the application process. We will delete your application documents no later than six months after completion of the application process. The legal basis for data processing is § 26 paragraph 1 sentence 1 Federal Data Protection Act.

Contact us

You have the possibility to contact us by electronic mail or telephone. Your data will only be used to answer your request. Your data will only be passed on to third parties if this is necessary to process your request. The legal basis for the use of your data is Article 6 paragraph 1 letter f GDPR. We have a legitimate interest in being in contact with the users of the website and in answering any questions you may have or sending you information. Your data will be deleted as soon as they are no longer required for the above-mentioned purposes. As a rule, we delete your request two weeks after final answering of your request.

Google Fonts

For the uniform representation of fonts, so-called web fonts are used on our website, which are provided by Google. When you call up a page, your browser loads the required web fonts into your browser cache in order to display texts and fonts correctly. For this purpose, the browser you are using must connect to our web servers, as we have integrated Google's web fonts locally. If your browser does not support web fonts, a standard font will be used by your computer.

Use of service providers

Ark-Biodiversity engages third parties to provide services and process your data (so-called order processing). The service providers process the data exclusively as instructed by Ark-Biodiversity and are obliged to comply with the applicable data protection regulations. All processors have been carefully selected and will only have access to your data to the extent and for the period necessary to perform the services.

Duration of data storage

We only store your data for as long as it is necessary for the provision of our services and there are no retention periods to prevent deletion.

Your rights as a user

As a user, you have the right to request information as to which data about you is stored by us and for what purpose it is stored. In addition, you can correct incorrect data or have such data deleted whose storage is inadmissible or no longer necessary. You have the right to data portability under Article 20 GDPR. In addition, you have the right to complain to a supervisory authority about the data processing taking place. If you have given us your consent, you can revoke it at any time with effect for the future.

Information on your right of objection

You have the right, for reasons arising from your particular situation, to object at any time to the processing of personal data concerning you pursuant to Article 21 of the GDPR, in particular on the basis of Article 6 (1) (e) or (f) of the GDPR. We will stop processing your personal data unless we can prove compelling reasons for processing worthy of protection which outweigh your interests, rights and freedoms, or the processing serves to assert, exercise or defend legal claims.
